Hi Gang,

I went to the US Air Force Academy 1981 - 1985 and learned to fly there. I eventually became an Air Force flight surgeon but have since retired from the US Air Force flight (pictured on right with terribly non photogenic expressions slightly in front of Lt Col Stiller in this photo). I have deployed multiple times to the Middle East in combat zones over the last 3 decades while living in Longmont and Broomfield. This is the most recent uniformed picture (2022) picture (from KBJC) flying with my replacement for Wyoming State Air Surgeon up to Cheyenne, WY from Broomfield on my last day of active duty. Also, I included a non GA photos as well (standing on wing of my USAF C-130H based out of Cheyenne, WY.

Starting in the 1990s, I was checked out to fly gliders at your airport (north side of KBDU) in Boulder then eventually the airplane side. I have been checked out in most of your fleet including all of the C-172s, the tricked out 150 HP C-150 (N6316S) and a DA-20 you used to have (or maybe still have). I fly from KBDU from KLMO and KBJC and also rented from Journeys at KBDU for currency and training and have flown with your CFIs for local Journey's GA rental checkouts and flight reviews as recently as 2021.
